

## What You Need To Know About *Disposable Heroes Paintball...*

Here is some info that will help you understand how we run our paintball games.

1. We organize paintball games because we enjoy it. We are not a business and we make no money from any game that we put on. What the players pay is what it costs us to buy the supplies and maintain the equipment that is required to run this paintball club.
2. We are very particular about who we ask to play with us. This means that there is rarely a case when an asshole is on the field with us. We do this for safety reasons, but also because great people make for great fun. We believe that anyone, regardless of age or sex or background, can have a great time playing paintball as long as they have a positive attitude.
3. We are unwavering in our commitment to safe paintball. All guns and equipment must meet our safety standards in order to be allowed on the field. We do not allow dangerous play at any time. Most likely due to #2 above, we have never had to eject anyone from a game.
4. We play scheduled games rain or shine. The only weather conditions that would prevent us from holding a scheduled game are sub-zero temps, a blizzard, or a hurricane. We have found that playing in the rain adds a new dimension to paintball... extreme stealth.
5. We do not offer refunds to players who cannot, for one reason or another, attend a game for which they have committed. This is because we acquire the supplies in advance for our games and we would lose money if people didn't show. We do, however, allow players to give their slots to other people who do want to attend (pending #2 above).
6. We play limited-style paintball. This means, among other things, that we limit the amount of paintballs that each player can carry with them in any given game. The reason for this is that we believe if players are allowed to carry large amounts of paint then the game becomes a blind splat-fest. Tactics are thrown out the window in favor of "shoot into the bush until one of 500 paintballs hits the guy." It is much more satisfying to out-play an opponent than to out-splat him.
7. We operate on the premise that an official's decision is final, period.
